




Online participation in the context of the Real Deal project

Various forms of online participation


- Synchronous: Online tools will be used to reproduce participatory processes online, or to complement face-to-face events
- Asynchronous: Online tools will be used in parallel to or in between face-toface events (platform)





The role of the Real Deal online platform

- Online participation as a support to the various deliberative processes organised in the context of Real Deal
- Real Deal platform relies on DECIDIM
- Aim of the platform is to :
 - reinforce the interactions between stakeholders and citizens through a sequential approach
 - foster debates among citizens across European countries through the multilingual add-on
 - include citizens, who would not participate in deliberations otherwise
 - · support transparent communication and documentation of processes and results







Tools provided by the platform

Tool	Short description
Proposal	Collection of ideas which can be endorsed, geolocalised or categorised
Survey	Implementation of various kinds of questionnaires
Meetings	Reinforce the link between digital and physical participation by informing on physical events and tracking their progress
Sortition	Enable sortitions among various proposals
Debates	Similar to proposal but allowing longer thread of comments
Poll	Allow for voting on a specific topic according to rules defined by the initiator of the process
Accountability	Aims to make the progression of a process more visible
News	Allow interaction among users via comments (similar to blogs)
Page	Allow for setting up information pages with the inclusion of various sources such as video or pictures










The participatory processes




- 7 participatory processes:

Different use of the platform














Activity on the platform













Some reflections

- Importance of coordination of the online and offline activities
- Using online tools before the real event seems to be beneficial for the activities on the platform
- Platform enables participants to pursue the discussion beyond the events
- Establishing a European dialogue is challenging.
- Key challenge: Activation of users to subscribe and participate on the platform, esp. the ones not attending the events
- Difficulty of the language: Keep comments and contributions as simple as possible
